At that stage a regulation was passed that all coaches in the Union will belong to the Coaches Association.  To accommodate this, the top structure of the Coaches Association was structured in such a manner that that it could and would meet the needs of the coaches affiliating the Association.  A business plan was drawn up for the Association as they was planning to run the Association like a business.  A "Bosberaad" was held to identify the mission and vision of the Association.  In order to develop the best coaches in the country the structures must be in place, a coach should join the coaches association to become a better coach.
